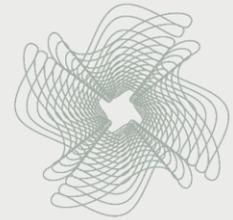


Cookies Policy



What are Cookies?

Cookies are harmless text files that web servers can store on your computer's hard drive, smart phone or other device when you visit a website. They allow the server to recognise you when you re-visit. There are two main types:

- **Session cookies.** These only exist for the duration of your site visit and are deleted on exit. They recognise you as you move around the site.
- **Persistent cookies** - These are cookies, which remain on your device after you have visited the SynerGIS website. Persistent cookies help us identify you as a unique visitor; they do not contain information that could be used to identify you to another person.

At SynerGIS, we use both types of cookie.

In addition, cookies can be first or third-party cookies. First-party cookies are owned and created by the website you're viewing. Third-party cookies are owned and created by an independent company, usually a company providing a service to the owners of the website.

What does SynerGIS use the cookies for?

Our site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to provide you with a better online experience.

Which type of cookies does SynerGIS use?

- **Tracking (transient) cookies** – These help us with statistics for who is using / visiting our sites
- **Login (persistent) cookies** – These are required for users that need to log in to services provided by the site

Whilst you are under no obligation to accept our cookies, certain logging features on our websites may not work efficiently if you choose to delete them. This may result in a loss of convenience.

Changing your cookie settings

To enable or disable cookies, follow the instructions provided by your web browser (usually this is located within the 'Help', 'Tools' or 'Edit' facility).

Please be aware that restricting cookies may mean that you will not be able to take full advantage of all the features or services available on this website.
